

5. The Permittee shall allow, upon reasonable notice, Commission staff or their agents access to facilities and search activities.
6. The Permittee shall provide the Commission a map and description of the site and debris field (if any) upon completion of this permit activity.
7. A monthly progress report shall be provided by the Permittee to the Commission.
8. A final report indicating methodology, techniques, maps, photographs or slides, survey data, findings and conclusions shall be submitted to the Commission no later than six (6) months following the conclusion of the permit activity and prior to any further permit consideration.
9. The Permittee shall not disclose exact location or coordinates of any cultural resources located.
10. In no way shall the Commission, the State of Alabama, their agents or employees, be held liable for any accident, incident, or cost incurred by this permit activity.
11. The rights and approvals granted to the Permittee by the Commission for this permit activity shall in no way be transferred or subcontracted to any other individuals or companies.

Issuance of this permit by the Commission to the Permittee shall in no way negate the responsibility of the Permittee from obtaining any and all federal or state permits or approvals or complying with any or all federal or state laws or regulations.

Issuance of this permit by the Commission to the Permittee shall in no way negate the State of Alabama's ownership of all shipwrecks shipwreck sites, debris fields, inundated archaeological sites, or any and all artifacts located by the permit activity.
